


NTU Library is housed in a two-story









Department wise Membership Status 2024



Campus Visit from Government Islamia College, Sargodha Road, Faisalabad




Collection Development (FY 2023-2024)








Circulations Statistics

No. of Books Issued Evening (02:00am to 09:00pm)







