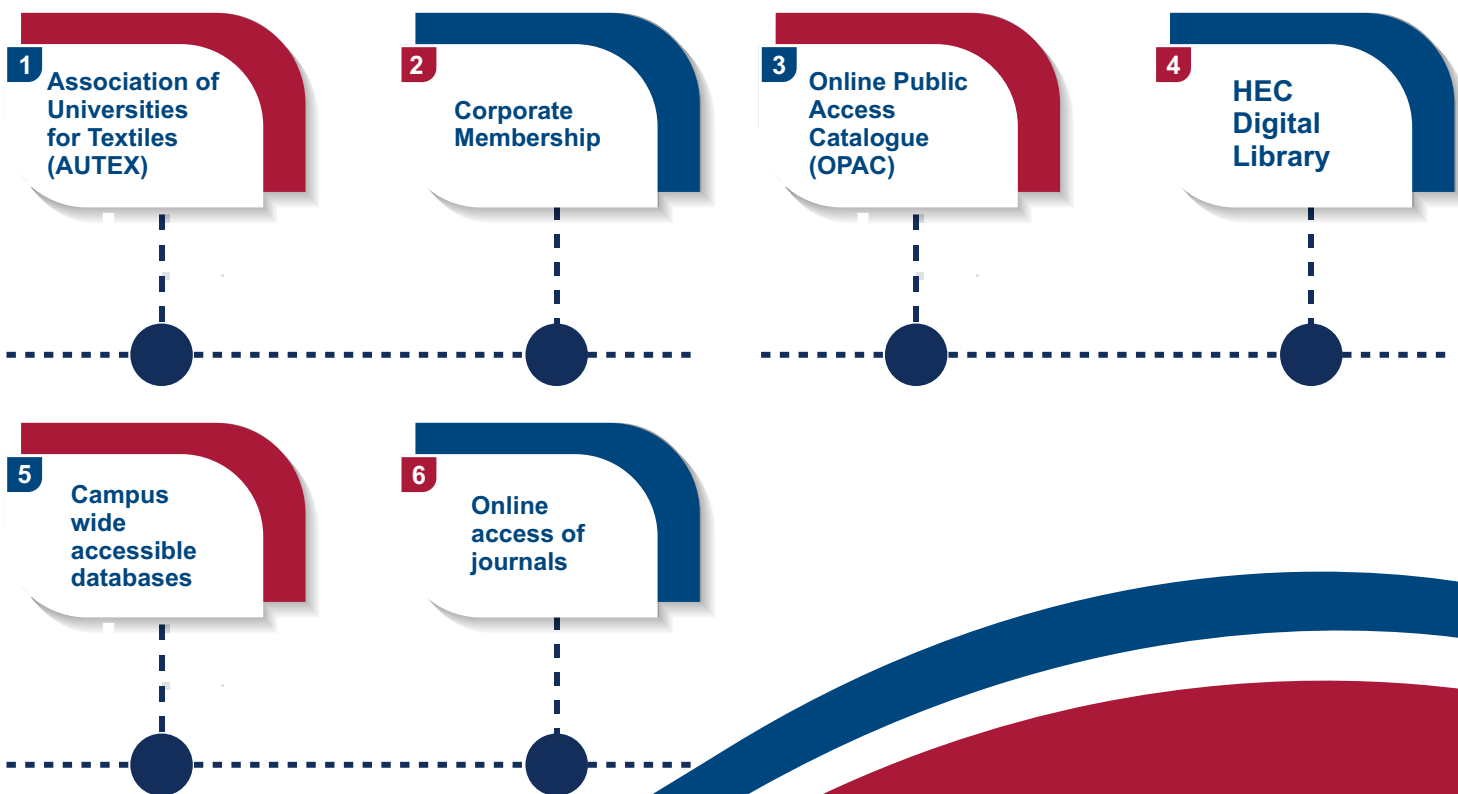

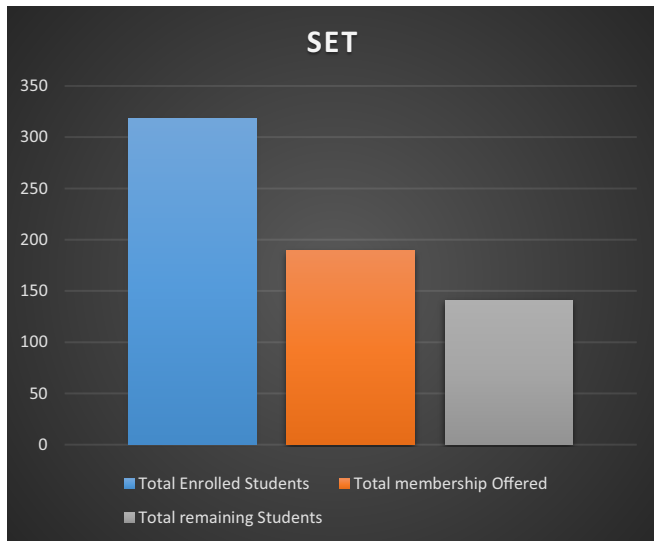

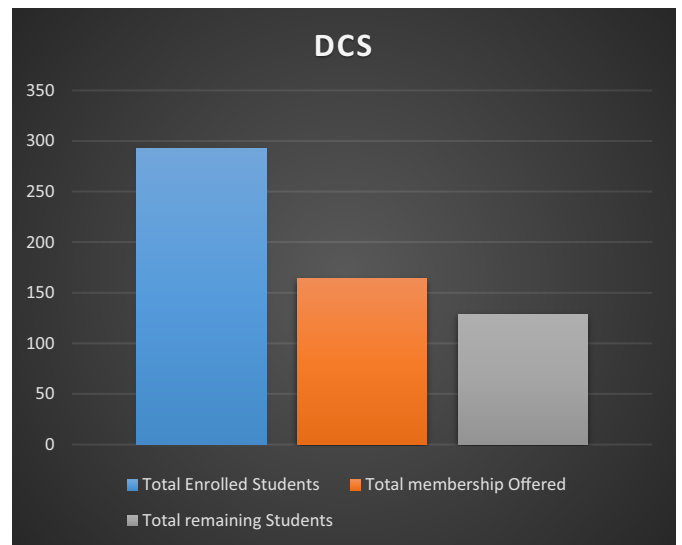
Department wise Membership Status 2024

Library membership week was celebrated for new enrolled students, faculty and staff members. Ms. Areeba Saleem, Library Assistant performed the duties during this week.

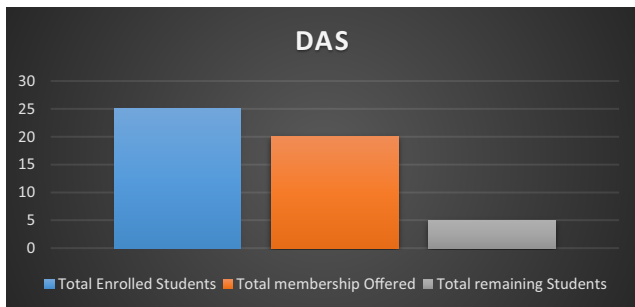

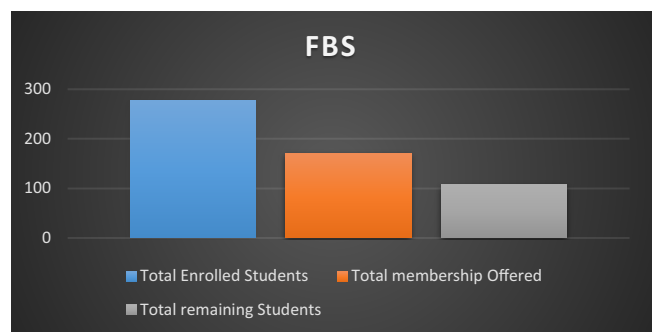

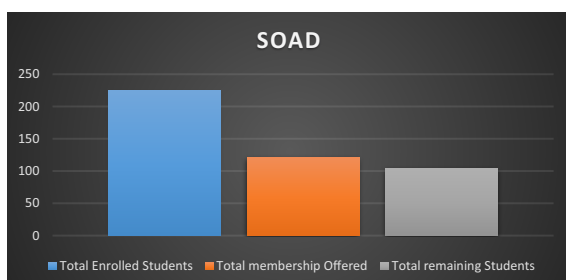

Collection Development (FY 2023-2024)



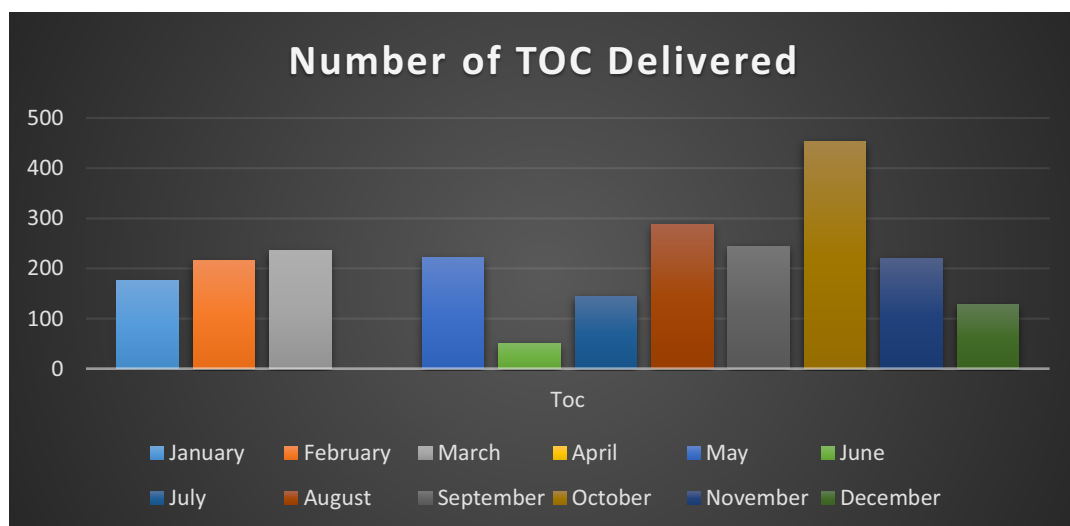

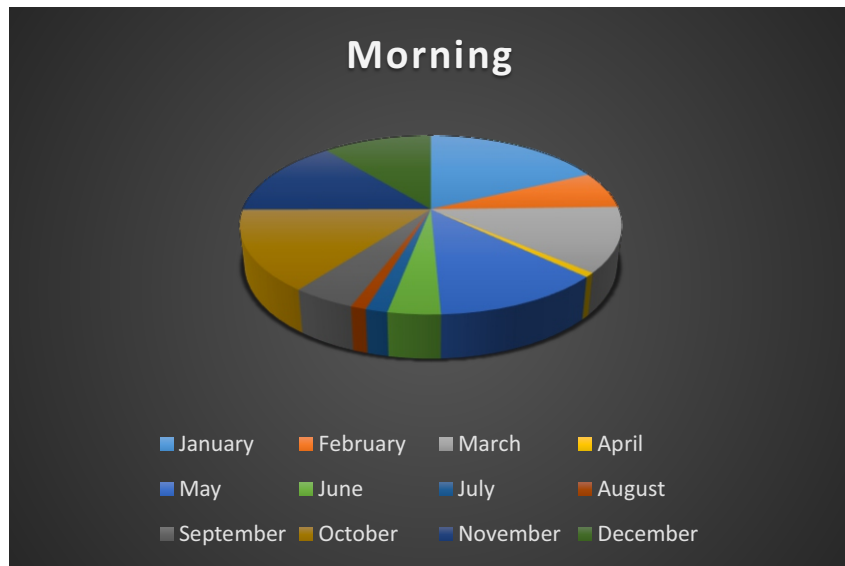

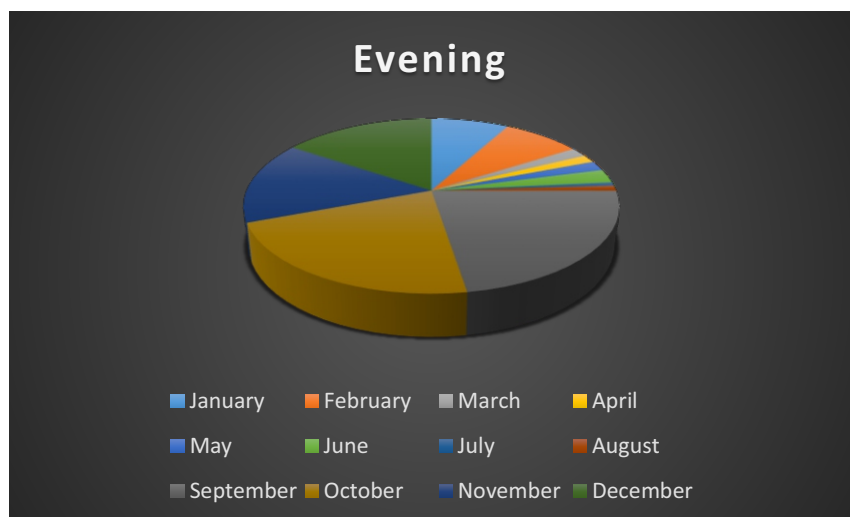


Circulations Statistics

No. of Books Issued Evening (02:00am to 09:00pm)

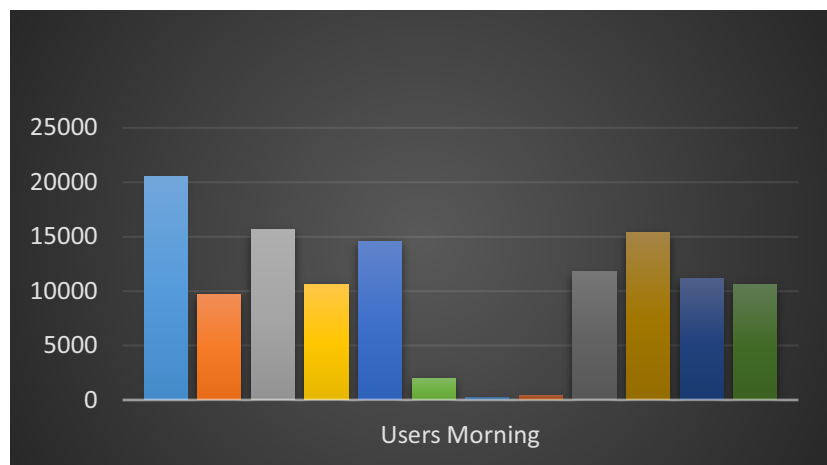

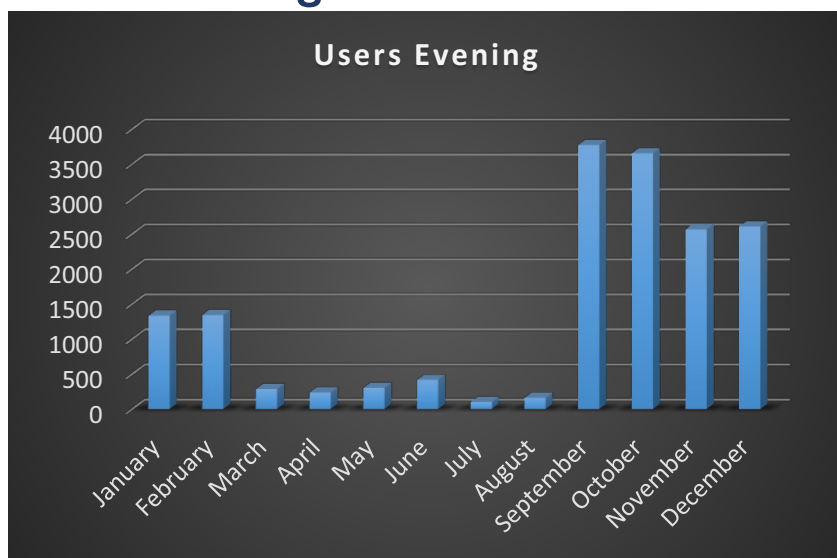


User's Statistics

- Evening






