Be sure to also visit our state-of-the-art libraries to familiarize yourself with all the exciting services and assistance available there.

Disciplinary Rules- Students Code of Conduct



Exemplary conduct is expected from the students. Their behavior should not impair or disturb the academic environment of the university. Any breach of discipline by the students due to his/her involvement in the obnoxious activities for any reason whatsoever may result in strict disciplinary action him/her.

Disciplinary sanctions are likely to be imposed on students who engage in any of the following.

- To obstruct other students for non-attendance of classes, unauthorized attending irrelevant classes, making noise in front of the ongoing classes, unnecessary presence in front of class rooms are strongly prohibited.
- Undue harassment, fooling of other students, physical abuse, misconduct and unruly behavior are not allowed in the campus.
- No student will be allowed for smoking/drug etc in the campus as it is a “No Smoking Zone” to keep the environment friendly and good hygienic atmosphere. Any student found breaching this rule will be fined Rs. 1000/- or any other punishment university deems fit.
- Possession, use, selling, distributing, or dispensation of alcohol, illegal drugs, firearms, or any other materials/substances prohibited by law on University premises or at University sponsored events.
- In order to promote basic Islamic and professional norms of decent behavior, morality and ethics, all the students are directed that **sitting of male and female students in couples in the University campus is strongly prohibited**. However, male and female students are permitted to sit together in groups inside the class rooms, computer lab and library provided they keep a reasonable distance between them. Any student who fails to observe/ violate these codes of conduct would be fined Rs. 1,000/- for 1st time offender and their case may be sent to the Disciplinary Committee for persistent offenders.
- **Verbal or physical abuse of any person or conduct** that threatens or endangers the health and safety of any such person.
- Theft of University property or of property of member of the University community on campus.
- Willful, wanton, or reckless damage to University premises, property or the property of a member of the University community.
- Obstruction or disruption of teaching or other component of the academic process, administration or University activity.
- **Harassment, sexual or otherwise. Or intimidation of any member of the University community while on University premises or during University sponsored events.**
- **Dress Code:** For girls and boys, improper/inappropriate dress e.g. Short or worn-out, sleeveless, skin tight, see through or revealing cloths, clothing with derogatory offensive and/or lewd messages either in words or pictures, chappals /slippers & boys with long hairs, pony tails, ear rings, chains, wrist straps bracelets & girls with T-shirts & jeans , heavy jewelry are not allowed.
- **Personal celebrations/** parties, birthday, class reunions and color days etc. within campus are not allowed.
- **No individuals and groups of male and female** are allowed to sit together in cafeteria. Students must sit according to the designated sitting areas that is separate for male and female students.
- Students must wear University ID Cards all the time in university/ campus premises as well as bus.
