DC VISITS NATIONAL TEXTILE UNIVERSITY: Deputy Commissioner (DC) Sardar Saifullah Dogar Tuesday visited National Textile University and inspected its different sections.

On the occasion, the DC said the varsity was playing very important role in terms of research and development for the uplift of the textile industry according to modern needs.

Rector Prof Dr Tanvir Husain briefed the DC on the available education and research facilities of textile technology in the varsity. Registrar Salman Saif, AC Shumaila Manzoor and others were also present. The DC said Faisalabad was the hub of textile industries and linkage be-

tween the varsity and textile industry should be strengthened more for introducing innovations in textile production. He stressed upon devising business models for making the textile products of Pakistan popular on world level for earning maximum foreign exchange. He said there was vast potential of development in textile industry which should be explored for generating the business activities and creating the employment opportunity.

The DC took a round of weaving, spinning, processing, computer textile designing, fiber technology, textile laboratory and other sections of the varsity and said the input of university management would be welcomed for the finalisa-

tion of master plan of Faisalabad city. He assured allout support of district administration for the extension of the varsity campus, educational and research facilities.

Rector Prof. Dr. Tanvir Husain informed during his briefing that this institution had achieved the status of the varsity from Textile Institute which was established in 1959. He said more than 3,000 students were studying in different textile departments of the varsity and offered the services of university for research and development in the relevant fields. Later, the DC planted a sapling in the varsity lawn and urged maximum tree plantation at available places.
